






#### What is Spaces?

Spaces is Perplexity Al's answer to ChatGPT and Claude's Projects feature.

It gives you a dedicated workspace where you can organize your research, upload files, and interact with your materials all in one place.












### Think of Spaces as your personal knowledge hub

In a Space, you can:

- Upload research papers, PDFs, or links
- Add custom instructions to guide how the assistant behaves
- Save ongoing conversations
- Invite collaborators to join your project









# One of the best parts? The search options

You can choose exactly where to search:

- Only your uploaded files
- Just the links you've added
- Or go broad: Web + Files + Links for comprehensive results

Perfect when you want to focus—or when you want it all.









#### Example: Literature Review

Let's say you're writing a literature review on "Al in Education."

Here's how Spaces can help:

- Upload all your collected readings
- Ask for summaries, themes, arguments, counterpoints
- Check if your research question has already been tackled
- Get new angles and ideas you might've missed









#### **Bonus: Collaboration**

Working with a research partner or supervisor? Invite them to your Space.

Everyone sees the same files and can interact with the assistant inside the shared workspace.










#### One note about access
